PIPAC TRAINING WORKSHOP OVERVIEW

Pressurized intraperitoneal aerosolized chemotherapy (PIPAC) is an innovative treatment for patients with peritoneal metastases originating from gastrointestinal and ovarian cancers-conditions for which effective therapies are limited. PIPAC is delivered during standard laparoscopy. The International Society for the Study of Pleura and Peritoneum (ISSPP) oversees certification and quality assurance for this procedure. Surgeons are recommended to complete a dedicated training program.

PIPAC is an emerging and promising treatment for patients with peritoneal metastases from gastrointestinal and ovarian cancers. As a relatively new approach, this marks only the third PIPAC training course in the United States designed to train and certify practitioners in its administration.

- Day One: Didactic lectures and videos
- Day Two: Dry lab simulation with lectures followed by hands-on exposure to aerosolizer and equipment
- Course exam and certification
